Our journey began with Brendan Foster being inspired to start running after watching a barefoot Abebe Bikila winning the 1960 Olympic Marathon in Rome. Brendan went on to compete in three Olympic Games and became European and Commonwealth Champion at 5,000 and 10,000m plus a World Record Holder.

During his time as an athlete competing at the top level of the sport he ran in the Round the Bays event in Auckland, New Zealand, and decided to bring the concept back to his native North East. The first Great North Run, the original Great Run, was staged in 1981.

Since its first staging when 10,000 runners took part, it has grown into the world's greatest half marathon and the UK's biggest running event with 57,000 runners annually. In 2014 the Great North Run became the first event in the world to be officially recognised by the IAAF for achieving the milestone one millionth finisher. The Great North Run formula has been used to develop a series of events staged in cities across the UK under the Great Run brand. Our events now extend over multiple days and include family activity.

Our mission is to create challenging events, which engage communities, generate significant local economic impact, promote health and fitness and support charity fundraising. Our events offer people of all abilities the chance to run with the world's best athletes and raise millions of pounds for charity. We encourage people, young and old, to get fit and active; inspiring them to lead healthier and happier lives.

"Running is a human instinct, it's in our DNA to be active. Running has always been part of my life, it's my passion. As runners, we want other people to run. It's an evangelistic thing, and if you run together, you run better. So, we created the Great North Run".

At the heart of the Great North Run is a magic that is difficult to put your finger on, but we have long known it is all down to the people; the people that run it, the people that watch and cheer the runners on, the people that volunteer their time to help and the people that organise it. There is little exists that can beat the atmosphere on the day of the Great North Run. We present a challenge to people that they can strive for. We encourage them and empower them, and in doing so they prove themselves. The sense of achievement and pride is immense, and they become their very own greatest." The 40th Great North Run will take place on Sunday 13th September 2020.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. All charities must acknowledge and adhere to the specified dates and deadlines for the return of all charity correspondence.
- 2. The closing date for the reservation of charity level packages is Friday 11 October 2019.
- 3. Due to demand for entries, Great Run cannot guarantee charities will be allocated the same number of entries as in 2019. Any charity that has found difficulty in filling their entry allocation in the past may be asked to reduce their entries in 2020.
- 4. All submissions for entries and packages are requests only and charities will be notified week ending 18 October 2019 whether they have been successful or not. All decisions are final.
- 5. Payment of package and entry fees are to be made payable to Nova International Ltd and are due 30 days net from date of invoice
- 6. The details of the packages are as stated; and are non-negotiable. Once payment has been made no refunds to the charity will be permissible.
- 7. The Great Run Company will commence activating the online management system on receipt of package payment.
- 8. The online management system gives all charities 100% flexibility in managing their entries until the pre-set closing dates for each event. This closing date will be announced in January 2020. Once entries have been submitted after the closing date no swapping of race numbers or transfer of entries is allowed. Any charity found to be doing so would be contravening their involvement with the event and the organisers would take relevant action.
- 9. Each charity must ensure their participants are informed about the importance of training and seeking medical advice before undertaking a training programme.
- 10. Each charity is required to ensure that participants who are unable to take part in their event once the closing date has passed are advised of the withdrawal procedure as set by the event organisers.
- 11. An invoice will be raised detailing the package and number of entries requested. Payment is due as per applicable deadlines. Refunds cannot be made for any unallocated entries, nor can places be rolled over to the following year.
- 12. Any charities with a number of Great North Run entries remaining unallocated by a date to be announced in January 2020 will be asked to enter the clearing system. The Great Run Company will then endeavour to reallocate those entries to a charity with spare capacity. The payment for transfer of entries will be between the charities involved.
- 13. Any charity that has requested a Platinum, Gold or Silver package will be sent further details regarding the Charity Village at a later date. The Great Run Company reserves the right to make changes to the Charity Village should any be required for health and safety or logistical reasons.
- 14. Charities must ensure that they have appropriate systems and procedures in place to ensure the security of participants' personal data from unauthorised processing.
- 15. Charities must ensure that they have appropriate consent from each participant to share personal details (name and email address) with Great Run so that Great Run can email the participant in order to fulfil their event entry.
